

Liteplan's emergency products are fitted with a charge indicating LED.

A Solid Green light indicates that the Battery Charge is healthy.

Self-Test and DALI emergency products are fitted with a Bi-Colour LED and basic with Green and indicate as follows:

- A **Solid Green light** indicates that the Battery Charge is healthy.
- A **Green Flashing light** indicates that the unit is in pre-commissioning mode, or there is either a Function or Duration Test in progress or that a test has taken place recently
- A **Red Flashing, Red Solid or Extinguished light** indicates that there is a fault on the unit.

Please refer to following chart below for more complete descriptions/fault indication:-
